Short description:

Taiwan has been maintaining great economic relationship with the Czech Republic for years. Taiwanese companies have invested in the EU and are very successful: e.g. investment in the Czech Republic has increased steadily, reaching \$US 213 million by September 2006, creating more than 7,000 jobs. One of the major investment projects – the Czech subsidiary of Foxconn Electronics Inc. – has become the country's 8th largest company and its 2nd largest exporter. Regarding national economic interest and cross-strait affairs management, Czech Republic needs to understand the Taiwan future situation while taking over EU presidency in 2009.
